

PERRY COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2012-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF PERRY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ENACTING AN UNCOVENITONAL GAS WELL FEE PURSUANT TO ACT 13 OF 2012

WHEREAS, Act 13 of 2012 amends the Oil and Gas Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to provide for an unconventional gas well fee or local impact fee; and

WHEREAS, said Act 13 further provides for its administration, distribution, and allowable uses; and

WHEREAS, said Act 13 further regulates permitting for unconventional gas wells, regulates environmental matters relative to said gas wells, reenacts relevant parts of the Oil and Gas Act and provides for matters relating to municipal zoning and land uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts an ordinance providing as follows:

Section 1. The County of Perry, Pennsylvania, hereby imposes an unconventional gas well fee on each unconventional gas well spud in Perry County, Pennsylvania, as authorized by Title 58.

Section 2. Definitions: The following words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Fee." The unconventional gas well fee imposed under section 2302 of Title 58.

"Spud." The actual start of drilling of an unconventional gas well.

"Title 58." Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes as amended by the Act of February 13, 2012 (P.L. ___, No.___) known as Act 13 of 2012.

"Unconventional Gas Well." A bore hole drilled or being drilled for the purpose of or to be used for the production of natural gas from an unconventional formation.

- Section 3. The unconventional gas well fee shall be applicable, and shall be administered, as provided by Title 58.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until repealed or amended.
- Section 5. A copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Public Utility Commission as required by Title 58.
