[A] Per the terms of the Company's Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement Stipulation at Docket No. R-2018-3000124, the Company allocated the tax refund between the Company's various rate classes based on the "Base Rate Revenue at Settlement Rates" as presented on Appendix B, page 1, column H.

[B] The fixed, one-time bill credit was provided to customers of record as of December 1, 2018 in each of these rate classes (individual customer credits for Medium C&I, Large C&I and Rate SM and average customer class credits for the others). The credit was provided during the January 2019 billing cycle.

[C] The Company calculated an individual refund for Medium C&I, Large C&I and Rate SM for each customer based on their percentage of actual base distribution revenue to the class distribution revenue for the period December 1, 2017 through November 30, 2018. The average, one time bill credit for these customers is for illustrative purposes only.
