PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION

Pursuant to the Prehearing Conference Order issued on May 20, 2021, by Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge ("DCALJ") Joel H. Cheskis and Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") John M. Coogan, United States Steel Corporation ("U.S. Steel"), hereby submits this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On April 16, 2021, Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne" or "Company") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") Supplement No. 25 to the Company's Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 ("Filing"), representing a request for a general increase in the Company's electric distribution rates of approximately \$115 million to be effective June 15, 2021. The Company is also requesting a return on equity ("ROE") of 10.95 percent. On May 24, 2021, U.S. Steel filed a Petition to Intervene to participate in this proceeding. A description of U.S. Steel is set forth in its Petition to Intervene.

III. ANTICIPATED ISSUES

U.S. Steel is still evaluating Duquesne's Filing and anticipates being informed by the record created in this case. At this preliminary stage, however, U.S. Steel plans to pay careful attention to the proposed overall revenue increase, the allocation of costs among the various rate schedules, and Duquesne's proposed overall Return on Equity of 10.95%. U.S. Steel anticipates pursuing these issues during this proceeding and reserves the right to raise further issues and to respond to all matters raised by other parties.

IV. PROPOSED WITNESSES AND EVIDENCE

U.S. Steel is still in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. In the event U.S. Steel decides to sponsor testimony, U.S. Steel will inform the parties, the DCALJ, and ALJ if this changes. Regardless, U.S. Steel reserves the right to participate in this proceeding and adduce evidence through the submission of discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions, and reply exceptions, if necessary.

V. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES

U.S. Steel will cooperate with the DC ALJ, ALJ, and the parties to formulate a reasonable procedural schedule and discovery rules in accordance with the Commission's regulations and DCALJ and ALJ directives.

VI. SETTLEMENT

U.S. Steel is willing to participate in settlement discussions so as to narrow or resolve issues in dispute among the parties.
