On April 1, 2022, Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne) filed a solar Power Purchase Agreement for approval to implement the procurement of certain energy and solar Alternative Energy Credits from a solar generation facility in Pennsylvania sponsored by Pine Gate Renewables, LLC. In order for us to complete our analysis of the subject filing, the Bureau of Technical Utility Services requires answers to the enclosed data requests. 
