Act 13 of 2012 provides for the imposition of an unconventional gas well fee (also called a drilling impact fee), and the expenditure of the funds generated by that impact fee to local, county, and state government purposes specifically outlined in the law. Under the law, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission administers the collection and disbursement of the fees.

Pursuant to Section 2314 (h) of the Act, the Commission is required to submit an annual report listing all deposits and expenditures of the fund by December 30, 2012. The following report contains all specified attachments and exhibits detailing the year one collections and disbursements.

UNCONVENTIONAL GAS WELL FUND

This fund was created under the authority of Act 13 of 2012 to fund programs impacted by the spudding of Unconventional Gas wells. The revenues are generated by fees, based on various well conditions, imposed on the permitted producers of such wells beginning in 2011. The Public Utility Commission is responsible for the receipt and disbursement of funds and the Department of Environmental Protection has regulatory control oversight.
