## STATEMENT OF CHAIRMAN GLADYS M. BROWN

In my Statement issued at the July 12, 2017 Public Meeting, I indicated that I could not, in good conscience, approve this Application based on the information that was before us at the time.

On July 21, 2017, Wenger Works, Inc., t/a Tuktuk Lancaster (Tuktuk) filed a Petition for Declaratory Order seeking a determination that its proposed transportation services are exempt from Commission regulation and that a Certificate of Public Convenience is not necessary to provide the service in connection with its sightseeing business.

In its Petition, Tuktuk, Inc. presented information to answer questions I posed in my Statement. Just as important, the statutory process providing for this petition supplied another opportunity for Tuktuk to clarify the information in its Application pertaining to the primary focus of the business. I would like to thank the company for providing essential information necessary to make an informed decision. As such, I agree with the staff recommendation that the service provided by Tuktuk is not under our jurisdiction.
