TO: ALL ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES AND ELECTRIC GENERATION SUPPLIERS

RE: Alternative Energy Program Standards Credit Compliance Summit

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) through its Bureau of Conservation, Economics and Energy Planning (CEEP) is hosting an Alternative Energy Program Standards (AEPS) Credit Compliance Summit on June 17, 2010.

The purpose of the meeting is to bring together all of the Electric Distribution Companies (EDCs) and Electric Generation Suppliers (EGSs) who may have AEPS credit compliance obligations for the 2009-2010 and/or 2010-2011 compliance years. The meeting will include presentations by PUC staff, the AEPS Credit Administrator, a representative of Generation Attribute Tracking System (GATS) and the Department of Environmental Protection to discuss their roles in ensuring AEPS compliance and to discuss our expectations for EDCs and EGSs in fulfilling their AEPS obligations.

Participation in the Summit is required by each EDC and EGS that had Pennsylvania retail electric sales during June 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010 or that anticipates having such sales during the June 1, 2010 to May 31, 2011 period. Company representatives may participate in the Summit by attending in person or via conference call. Our preference is for at least one representative from each EDC and EGS to attend the Summit if possible. Companies may have more than one representative participate in the Summit if they wish. Representatives participating in the Summit should either be those: 1) responsible for AEPS compliance obligations; or 2) possessing a working knowledge of AEPS requirements and able to bring the information provided at the Summit back to the persons at their respective companies who are responsible for AEPS compliance.

The meeting will be held in the Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. We have reserved Hearing Room 1 on the second floor from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. on June 17, 2010 for the meeting.

We believe that this meeting will be beneficial for those EDCs and EGSs that have had AEPS compliance obligations in the past and particularly beneficial for companies that will have compliance obligations for the first time in the 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 compliance years.
