Approved applications for Bux-Mont Yellow Cab & Bux-Mont Transportation Service (**Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties**); Health Ride Plus Inc. (**Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Centre Clarion, Clearfield, Elk, Indiana, Huntingdon, Jefferson, Mifflin and Somerset counties**); Henderson Limousine Service Inc.; Hollowsands LLC (**Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties**); U-Call We-Haul U-Save (**Bucks County**); and **Pennsylvania American Water Co.**

**Ratified** the emergency temporary authority of **Transportation Management Services Inc.**

**Denied the application for** Lenora's Moving Co. (**Philadelphia County**).

**Approved the license amendment for** Agway Energy Services LLC.

**Made public** the auditor's report on the transmission service charge for **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**

**Adopted the tentative order** to receive comment on additional data sharing among **electric distribution companies (EDCs)** and **electric generation suppliers (EGSs)**; streamlining the current safety valve process for **additional numbering resources**; tentatively revoked **George Fleeher/Fleeher Sewage Treatment Plant's** certificate of public convenience; and issuing for comment and beginning the implementation of the **Gas and Hazardous Liquids Pipelines Act.**

**Adopted the proposed opinions and orders** appointing Stephen H. Schultz to serve on the **PA Relay Service Advisory Board** for a two-year term terminating on March 30, 2014; denying the petition of appeal in part and granting the petition of appeal in part in the case of Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS) vs. McGill's Cab Service Inc. (**Philadelphia County**); denying the company's exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision allowing the petition for leave to be

withdrawn without prejudice regarding the Jan. 19, 2010, complaint in the case of the PPL Industrial Customer Alliance vs. **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**; denying the exceptions, dismissing the complaint and remanding the proceeding to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for the limited purpose of developing a record and an initial decision on remand in the case of Orlando Rivera vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; granting the petition for reconsideration in part and denying it in part, rescinding the order entered Oct. 14, 2011, and referring the matter to the Bureau of Technical Utility Services for processing regarding the application of Ameriquest Ambulance (**Bucks, Montgomery, and Philadelphia counties**) for certain paratransit rights; approving the proposed settlement in the case of BTS vs. Capital City Cab Co. (**Dauphin County**); approving the proposed settlement in the case of BTS vs. Best Value Limousine Inc. (**Lackawanna and Luzerne counties**); denying the exceptions, adopting the initial decision as modified by the opinion and order, granting the preliminary objections, in part and denying them in part, and dismissing the complaint in the case of Haleema Alkhatib vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Lidia Shan vs. **Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.**; approving the proposed settlement in the case of BTS vs. Ladybug Transportation & Construction Inc. (**Lawrence County**); granting reconsideration, pending review of, and consideration on, the merits regarding the petition for reconsideration of the order filed by Daum Transport (**Bradford County**); denying the appeal of the Borough of Braddock (**Allegheny County**) regarding two tracks of CSX Transportation in the Borough of Braddock, granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection, collocation and resale agreement between **Qwest Communications** and **CenturyLink**; and that the exceptions filed by the Met-Ed Industrial Users Group, the Penelec Industrial Customer Alliance and the Penn Power Users Group to the recommended decision, and the Exception Seeking Clarification filed by **Metropolitan Edison Co. (Met-Ed), Pennsylvania Electric Co. (Penelec)**

and **Pennsylvania Power Co. (Penn Power)**, to the recommended decision are granted and that the ALJ's recommended decision is adopted regarding the first amended energy efficiency and conservation plans of Met-Ed, Penelec and Penn Power.

**Instituted an investigation** in to the proposed rate increase request of **Aqua Pennsylvania Inc.**

**Approved the proposed letter of notification** for **Duquesne Light Co.** for reconductoring both circuits and increasing the voltage on one circuit of a .47-mile long transmission line in the **City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County**; and for **Met-Ed** for approval of the construction of the Yorkana-West Hellam 115-kV tap line to the Prospect Distribution Substation Project in Lower Windsor Township, **York County**.

**Approved the proposed rulemaking order** to review the exemption from **natural gas supplier** licensing requirements for marketing services consultants and nontraditional marketers.

**Granted** the request of **Windstream Pennsylvania LLC** for additional numbering resources in the 724, 570 and the 814 area codes.

**Granted** the request of **Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.** for 1,000 telephone numbers in the 484/610 area codes.

**Approved the 911 system renewal plans for Wyoming County.**

**Adopted the ALJ's initial decisions** dismissing the formal complaint in the case of Wanda M. Ramaley vs. **Penn Power**; dismissing the complaint with prejudice in the case of Michelle Adderton vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; dismissing the complaint in the case of Rameses Lee vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; sustaining the complaint and ordering the company to pay a civil penalty of \$2,000 in the case of BTS vs. Collegeville Airport Service (**Chester County**); dismissing the complaint with prejudice in the case of James & Patricia Reagan vs. **Duquesne Light Co.**; and dismissing the complaint without prejudice in the case of Jalla Buku vs. **PECO Energy Co.**

Inc., Wally Gas Co. and Chartiers Natural Gas Co. Inc.**
