Denied the rate increase for Rosemont Taxicab Co. Inc. (**Philadelphia County**).

Approved the assessment section computation in accordance with **Act 127 of 2011** for the amount of the assessment for Fiscal Year July 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, on each applicable pipeline operator.

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders granting the motion for extension of time to comply with the order filed by the township in the case of Blue Mountain/Reading Railroad in Fairview Township, **Luzerne County**; the \$5,000 settlement in the case of Law Bureau Prosecutory Staff vs. **Dominion Peoples**; denying the petition for reconsideration filed by the complainant in the case Catherine S. Brown vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of Montelagra Cooper vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the company's exceptions, adopting the ALJ's initial decision and sustaining the complaint in the case of Andrew Maholik vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Deborah Bethay vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the complainant's exceptions, adopting the ALJ's initial decision and directing that the case be marked closed in the case of Enos Curl vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; approving a \$150 settlement in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Best Limousine Co. Inc. (**Philadelphia County**); granting the petition to appeal staff action, rescinding the secretarial letter of June 14, 2012, and assigning the proceeding to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for further action as deemed necessary, in the case of I&E vs. Paul K. Brown Inc. (**Allegheny County**); granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection agreement between

Comcast Business Communications and **Frontier Communications Commonwealth Telephone Co.**; granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection agreement between **Comcast Business Communications** and **Frontier Communications of Breezewood, LLC**; and granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection agreement between **Comcast Business Communications** and **Frontier Communications of Pennsylvania, LLC**.

Approved the appointment of Beverly Weaver to the **Metropolitan Edison Co. and Pennsylvania Electric Co. Sustainable Energy Fund**.

Adopted the proposed orders approving the transfer of **Utility Rates Analysts'** electric generation supplier license to **URA Inc.**, approving the license application of URA Inc. and canceling the license of **Utility Rates Analysts**; and approving the petition filed by **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** for approval of new programs, several adjustments to its plan, and a 18-month extension to its grace period to continue to identify, test, develop and implement measures that fully meet the **Act 129 of 2008** requirements.

Adopted the final implementation order, establishing additional incremental reductions in electric consumption, and establishing the standards each plan must meet and providing guidance on the procedures to be followed for submittal, review and approval of all aspects of the energy efficiency and conservation plans for Phase II of **Act 129 of 2008**.

Adopted the final implementation order regarding the **Distribution System Improvement Charge (Act 11 of 2012)**.

Approved the 911 system renewal plans for Columbia, Lycoming and Susquehanna counties.

Adopted the ALJ's initial decision dismissing the complaints in the case of L. Richard Adamovich vs. **West Penn Power Co.**

Approved the motions of Commissioner Pamela Witmer regarding the binding poll addressing the joint petition of **Metropolitan-Edison Co., Penn Power** and **West Penn Power Co.** requesting approval of their default service plans for the period from June 1, 2013, through May 31, 2015.
