**Approved the application for discontinuance or abandonment of service** for Executive Car & Limousine Service Inc. (Union County).

**Adopted the proposed opinions and orders** granting the petition for reinstatement, subject to a condition, in the case of Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS) vs. The Reading Express Airport Shuttle (**Berks County**); granting the motion for default judgment in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement vs. **Angles Communication Solutions**; granting the company's exceptions, in part, and reversing the ALJ's initial decision in the case of Gail Debrow vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; granting the petition for reconsideration, rescinding the order entered Aug. 30, 2012, and referring the matter to the Bureau of Technical Utility Services for processing, regarding the application for certain paratransit rights of **Family Ties Transportation LLC**; denying the Motion to Strike filed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation on Oct. 1, 2012, with reference to the Petition for Reconsideration filed by **Reading Blue Mountain & Northern Railroad** on Sept.18, 2012, in the case of Carl Hill vs. **Reading Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad**; and granting the joint petitions for approval of interconnection agreements between Cingular Wireless and **North Penn Telephone**, Cingular Wireless and **Lackawaxen Telecommunications Services Co.**, Cingular Wireless and **Laurel Highland Telephone Co.**, Cingular Wireless and **Venus Telephone Co.**, Cingular Wireless and **South Canaan Telephone Co.**, Cingular Wireless and **Pymatuning Independent Telephone Co.**, Cingular

**Approved the proposed Section 703(g) order which approves the order** at docket number A-2012-2283821, regarding the application of **Xoom Energy Pennsylvania LLC** for approval to become a licensed electric generation supplier in the electric distribution companies service territories of **Duquesne Light Co.**, **Metropolitan-Edison Co.**, **Pennsylvania Electric Co.** , **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**, **PECO Energy Co.** and **West Penn Power Co.**

**Adopted the proposed orders** approving the indirect transfer of control and registering the securities certificate regarding the joint application of **A.R.C. Networks Inc.** and **Broadview Networks Inc.**; granting the joint petition for approval for a waiver of certain provisions of 52 Pa. Code and a letter of notification of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** for approval of the siting and construction of the Paupack-Honesdale No. 1 and No. 2 138/69 kV transmission line in Paupack, Palmyra and Cherry Ridge townships, Wayne County; and approving the letter of notification of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** with respect to the Blooming Grove-West Damascus Kimbles tap 138/69 kV transmission line reconstruction in Palmyra and Lackawaxen townships, Pike County.

**Approved the 911 system renewal plan for Northampton County.**

**Adopted the ALJ’s initial decision** granting the preliminary objection of the company and dismissing the complaint with prejudice in the case of David Moore Jr. vs. **PECO Energy Co. – Electric.**

**Adopted the ALJ’s recommended decision** approving the energy efficiency and conservation annual reconciliation report for **PECO Energy Co. – Electric.**

**Recorded and entered as the action of the Commission** the notational vote that South Fayette Township’s (**Allegheny County**) ordinance violates Chapter 32, Section 3302 and Section 3303 of **Act 13 of 2012** and that the township is immediately ineligible to receive any funds collected under Chapter 23 of **Act 13 of 2012** in the Request for Review, filed by Mr. William F. Sray, regarding the South Fayette Township Zoning Ordinances Regulating Oil and Gas Well Development and Processing.
