- Before the Commission is the end state of default electric service from its Office of Competitive Market Oversight (OCMO). This default service model was developed based on input from stakeholders participating in the Commission's Investigation of Pennsylvania's Retail Electricity Market, as well as a review of comments to the Commission's November 8 Tentative Order. Based upon the record developed during the Retail Markets Investigation, the Commission believes the default service model will improve competition in the current retail electric market.
