IMPLEMENTATION OF UNCONVENTIONAL GAS WELL IMPACT FEE ACT

- Governor Corbett signed into law Act 13 of 2012 on 2/14/12, the Unconventional Gas Well Impact Fee Act (Act 13 or Act), which amends Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes. Act 13 provides, inter alia, for an unconventional gas well fee, Oil and Gas Act amendments and standards for local ordinances. The PUC's administrative responsibilities for implementing the provisions of Act 13 are contained within Chapters 23 (relating to the unconventional gas well fee) and Chapter 33 (relating to local ordinances) of the Act. By this rulemaking, the Commission proposes to implement regulations that will assist us in carrying out our administrative responsibilities contained in Chapter 23 of the Act. Because the Commission is currently enjoined from carrying out its responsibilities contained in Chapter 33, this rulemaking is limited to Chapter 23 of the Act. RECOMMENDATION:
