Adopted the proposed opinions and orders denying the petition for reconsideration filed by **Reading Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad** regarding the August 2012 order in connection with construction plan for the demolition of the existing bridge and the construction of a new bridge to carry Mary Street over the tracks of the railroad in Fairview Township, **Luzerne County**; recording and entering the adoption of a final order by notational vote in the case of **Core Communications Inc. vs. AT&T Communications of Pennsylvania LLC** and **TCG Pittsburgh Inc.**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of **Mary Kingcade vs. PECO Energy Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the ALJ's initial decision in the case of **Raymond Kochis vs. Pennsylvania American Water Co.**; granting the respondent's exceptions, reversing the initial decision and dismissing the complaint in the case of **Thomas Angelou and Nicholas Angelou vs. Pennsylvania American Water Co.**; denying the petition for reconsideration filed by the company in the case of **Carl Hill vs. Reading Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad**; recording and entering as the action of the Commission a notational vote on a final order adopted on Dec. 31, 2012, regarding the application seeking contract carrier rights of **Lifestar Ambulance Inc. (Bucks, Chester and Montgomery counties)**; granting the joint petitions for approval of interconnection agreements of **Frontier Communications** and **Service Electric Telephone Co. LLC, Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.** and **Cricket Communications, Verizon North Inc.** and **Cricket Communications, Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.** and **Princeton Hosted Solutions, Verizon North Inc.** and **Princeton Hosted Solutions,**

Mahanoy and Mahantango Telephone Co. and Service Electric Telephone Co. LLC, **Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania Inc.** and Salsgiver Telecom Inc., and Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania Inc. and **Level 3 Communications LLC**; and granting the petition for reconsideration filed by the company pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits in the case of Mari Jensen vs. **PECO Energy Co.**

Adopted the proposed orders approving measures requiring parties serving pre-served testimony in proceedings pending before the Commission to either eFile (electronic file) with or provide to the Commission's Secretary's Bureau a CD containing all testimony furnished to the court reporter during a proceeding; and approving the petition of **Verizon North LLC** for temporary exemption of the requirements of 52 Pa. Code regarding operator handled calls and the speed of call answer metric.

Granted the petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corp. for approval of a long-term infrastructure improvement plan.

Adopted the proposed tentative order issuing for comment proposed revisions to the conservation service provider (CSP) registration process and application as a way to expedite the process and reduce administrative burdens as part of Phase II of **Act 129 of 2008**.

Approved the 911 system renewal plan for Fulton County.

Adopted the ALJ's initial decisions denying, in part, granting, in part, the complaint and ordering the company to provide the agreed upon written materials in the case of Michael Salko Jr. vs. **UGI Penn Natural Gas Inc.**; and granting the preliminary objections for lack of jurisdiction and otherwise dismissing the complaint in the case of Thai Van Thieu vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**.

Adopted the ALJ's recommended decisions accepting the **final generation supply charge reconciliation report** for **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** insofar as it is undisputed; accepting the **smart meter technologies charge – Section 1307(e) statement** for **Metropolitan Edison Co.** and **Pennsylvania Electric Co.** insofar as it is undisputed; and accepting the steam cost rate Section 1307(e) reconciliation statement setting forth the over/under collections for the 12-month period ended June 30, 2012, insofar as it is undisputed for **NRG Energy Center Pittsburgh LLC**.
