## Approved applications for Allegheny County;

G. Sweigart Transport Services (**Lancaster County**); Live Life Transportation Club LLC (**Lancaster County**); Clarion County Taxi Inc. (**Clarion County**); Atlantis Limousine Service LLC (**Montgomery, Bucks, Chester and Delaware counties**); Nolt's Van Service (**Lancaster County**); Gegen LLC; Success America (**Delaware County**); D&L Cab Co. (**York County**); Save Wave Energy LLC; SYR Solutions LP; Park Power LLC; Choose Energy Inc.; Pennsylvania American Water Co.; and Olwen Heights Water Service Co. Inc. (**Lackawanna County**).

Approved an application as amended for United Medical Care (**Montgomery County**).

Approved applications for discontinuance or abandonment of service for Dewayne Royer (**Clinton County**); and Energy Choice Solutions.

Approved an increase in rates for Read's Moving Systems Inc. (**Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties**); and Maroadi Transfer and Storage Inc. (**Allegheny County**).

Made public the quarterly earnings report for the third quarter of 2012 for non-telephone fixed utilities with jurisdictional operating revenues of over \$10 million.

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders denying the letter petition filed by the company relative to the request for a waiver regarding vehicle age that, unless otherwise permitted by the Commission, a vehicle may not be operated in limousine service which is more than eight model years old, for Ruffo's Auto Repair (**Westmoreland County**); denying the petition for appeal from staff action filed by the company in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Augustus Reed Jr. (**Allegheny County**);

granting the motion to strike the complainant's additional exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of Mary Jane Hodak and Judith Hodak vs. **Pennsylvania Electric Co.**; granting the petition for reconsideration or clarification of the Office of Consumer Advocate, pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits regarding **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.'s** Supplement No. 118 to Tariff – Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 containing proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations; granting the motion for default judgment in the case of I&E vs. **Lemirage Limousine**; denying the complainant's exceptions, adopting the initial decision and dismissing the complaint with prejudice in the case of Maria Povacz vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; approving joint petitions for approvals of interconnection agreements for **Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.** and **Voxbeam Telecommunications Inc.** and **Verizon North Inc.** and **Voxbeam Telecommunications Inc.**; and approving the default service plans for **Duquesne Light Co.** and **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** for the period of June 1, 2013, to May 31, 2015.

Approved the appointment of **Bernard Zavatone** to the **Sustainable Energy Fund of Central Eastern Pennsylvania's** board of directors; the tariff supplement of **Peoples Natural Gas Co.** for approval to propose to the revise rate local gas aggregation service's aggregation fee; the letter of notification of **Metropolitan Edison Co.** with respect to the Harley Davidson-Pleasureville 115-kV (986 line) transmission line reconductor project situated in Springettsbury Township, **York County**; and the vendor for **PAPowerSwitch.com** for the selection of maintenance and upgrade-related services.

Instituted investigations into the proposed rate increase requests of Imperial Point Water Service Co. (**Butler County**); and Rock Spring Water Co. (**Huntingdon County**).

**Adopted the proposed orders** amending the proposed regulations of the Commission at 52 Pa. Code Chapter 33 **regarding existing railroad transportation regulations**; issuing an advance notice of proposed rulemaking to solicit comments **regarding revisions to the Commission's existing regulations regarding unaccounted-for-water**; granting **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.'s** petition for temporary exemption from 52 Pa. Code to continue offering customers the opportunity to establish payment agreements through its website and interactive voice capabilities.

**Approved the 911 system renewal plan for Bradford County.**

**Adopted the ALJ's initial decision** granting the preliminary objections and dismissing the complaint in the case of Theresa Gavin vs. **PECO Energy Co.**

**Adopted the ALJ's recommended decisions** accepting the Section 1307(e) energy efficiency and conservation charge reconciliation statement of revenues and expenses of **Pennsylvania Power Co.** and **Metropolitan Edison Co.** for the year ended May 31, 2012, insofar as they are undisputed; accepting the Section 1307(e) gas cost rate reconciliation statement setting forth the over/under collections for the period of July 2011 through June 2012 insofar as they are undisputed for **NRG Energy Center Harrisburg LLC, Pike County Light and Power Co. – Gas** and **Veolia Energy Philadelphia Inc.**; accepting the Section 1307(e) annual smart meter reconciliation for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, for **Duquesne Light Co.**; accepting the Section 1307(e) gas cost rate reconciliation statements setting forth the over/under collections for the period ended Aug. 31, 2012, insofar as it is undisputed for **Herman Oil and Gas Co. Inc., Herman Riemer Gas Co.** and **Clarion River Gas – Division of Orwell Natural Gas Co.**

**Adopted the joint motion of Commissioners Gardner and Witmer** in the case of I&E vs. William C. Sutton (**Bradford County**).

**Adopted the joint motion of Chairman Powelson and Vice Chairman Coleman** in the case of I&E vs. **UGI Utilities, Inc.** The settlement was adopted with modifications.
