Approved applications for Star City Moving LLC; Park Avenue Luxury Limousine Inc. (**Montgomery, Bucks, Delaware, Chester and Philadelphia counties**); Kenneth Gill Heimbuch (**Allegheny County**); **Pennsylvania American Water Co. – Wastewater;** Extreme Health Care Services LLC (**Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Perry and York counties**); Safety 1st Paratransit Inc. (**Philadelphia and Delaware counties**); Carol Ann Frazier (**Centre County**); James A. Riggins Jr. (**Lancaster County**); **North American Power and Gas LLC;** Limo 1 (**Lehigh County**); **Jasmahn Energy; Emex LLC; Hovey Energy LLC; Affiniti PA LLC;** and **Stand Energy Corp.**

Approved applications for discontinuance or abandonment of service for People to Places Inc. (**Berks County**); Racing Limos of Harrisburg LLC (**Dauphin County**); Clyde L. Jackson Jr. (**Crawford County**); Hugh A. McKnight (**Snyder County**); Monk's Van Service (**Lancaster County**); and denied applicants of Passionate Car Service Inc. (**Philadelphia County**).

Denied an increase in rates for Western Berks Ambulance Association (**Berks County**).

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders granting the exceptions of Norfolk Southern Railway Co., modifying the recommended decision and approving the settlement, regarding the application of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, or PennDOT (**Mercer County**); denying the exceptions and modifying the initial decision in the case of A&S Deli vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; issuing for comment the settlement agreement between the Commission's Law Bureau Prosecutory Staff (LBPS) and **MXenergy Electric Inc.** regarding erroneous customer enrollments; issuing for comment the settlement agreement between the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) and **Public Power LLC** regarding erroneous customer

enrollments; issuing for comment the settlement agreement between I&E and **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** pertaining to alleged improper transfer to a restoration crew working to restore electric service in the wake of a snowstorm, which occurred on Oct. 29, 2011; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Jose and Carmen Feliciano vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; granting the exceptions of the company, modifying the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision and denying the complaint in the case of David Oliver vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; granting the petition to intervene filed by Michael Goretzka and JoAnn Goretzka in the case of I&E vs. **West Penn Power Co.**; approving the agreement, which includes a \$400 civil penalty, in the case of I&E vs. Mainline Taxi (**Montgomery County**); issuing for comment the \$1 million settlement agreement between I&E and **UGI Penn Natural Gas Co.** regarding the company's non-compliance with state and federal leak classification regulations; denying the petition for reconsideration filed by the complainant in the case of Kimberly Lopez vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; and granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection agreement of **Windstream Pennsylvania LLC** and **Comcast Phone of Pennsylvania LLC** and **Comcast Business Communications.**

Adopted the proposed orders appropriating the property, approving the right-of-way plan and approving the application directing PennDOT (**Allegheny County**) to replace the subject bridge located where State Route 0885, Section A35, crosses the above the single track of Union Railroad Co. and approaches thereto at its sole cost and expense; approving the letter of notification of **Duquesne Light Co.** approving the reconductoring and construction of new tie lines for existing transmission lines in the Borough of Dravosburg, West Mifflin and Jefferson Hills, **Allegheny County**, and Union Township, **Washington County**; approving **Duquesne Light Co.'s** Supplement No. 80 to Tariff Electric – PA PUC No. 24, eliminating surge protection service; reclaiming

six “blocks” of 1,000 telephone numbers from **RNK Inc.**; approving the petition of **Blue Jay Wireless LLC** for eligible telecommunications carrier designation as a facilities-based digital wireless carrier; granting the petition of PennDOT (**Lancaster County**) to transfer jurisdiction of its application to make alterations and improvements to public crossings at the tracks of Norfolk Southern Railway Co. in Columbia Borough, to the Court of Common Pleas of Lancaster County; approving the application of **Sunoco Pipeline LP** to abandon service on a portion of its intrastate petroleum products pipeline and approving a petition temporary suspending service on a portion of the company’s intrastate petroleum products pipeline transportation service; and approving Supplement No. 77 to Tariff Electric PA PUC No. 24 proposing to reinstate the consumer-education surcharge of **Duquesne Light Co.**

Adopted the proposed tentative order issuing for comment the proposed 2014 Technical Reference Manual in association with **Act 129 of 2008.**

Adopted the proposed final order addressing **Equitable Gas Co.’s universal service and energy conservation plan** for 2013-2015.

Adopted the ALJ’s initial decision granting, in part, that the complainant should be granted a second reduced payment arrangement in the case of Jonathan Bridges vs. **PECO Energy Co.**

Adopted the ALJ’s recommended decisions accepting **West Penn Power Co.’s annual 1307(e) reconciliation statement** for its energy efficiency and conservation surcharge for the period ending May 31, 2013; accepting **Utilities Inc. – Westgate’s purchased water agreement charge** for the period of July 1, 2012, to March 31, 2013; accepting the **generation supply charge-2 reconciliation report** for the period of May 1, 2012, through April 30, 2012, of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**; and accepting the **transmission service charge reconciliation report of PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** for the period of May 1, 2012, through April 30, 2013.

Adopted the motion of Commissioner Witmer in the case of Margarita Kron vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works.**

Adopted the motion of Commissioner Gardner in the case of I&E vs. Classic Limousines (**Montgomery, Chester and Philadelphia counties**).
