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**Approved applications for Constellation Energy Gas Choice Inc.; BP Energy Co.;** Pediatra Healthcare for Kids (**Philadelphia County**); Vital Express Limo Inc. (**Delaware and Montgomery counties**); **Pennsylvania American Water Co.;** FCStone LLC; Tony's Transit LLC (**Philadelphia County**); Berkshire Transportation Group LLC (**Berks County**); and **Guttman Energy Inc.**

**Approved the application amendment for GDF Suez Energy Retail Solutions LLC.**

**Approved the application** for Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT)(**Dauphin County**) regarding approval of the rehabilitation of the bridge carrying state route 3012 (Mulberry Street) above tracks of the National Railroad Passenger Corp. (AMTRAK) and Norfolk Southern Railway in Harrisburg, Dauphin County.

**Approved the application for approval of discontinuance or abandonment of service** for Central Pennsylvania Limousine Service (**Dauphin, Lancaster, York and Cumberland counties**).

**Denied the application of Rock Star Limousine LLC.**

**Adopted the proposed orders** approving the letter of notification of **West Penn Power Co.** for approval of the proposed Armstrong-Kittanning 138-kV and Armstrong-Kissinger 138-kV transmission line relocation project in Washington Township, **Armstrong County**; and approving the tariff supplement for approval to delete Rider A – qualified advanced meters and meter-related devices for **Citizens' Electric Co. of Lewisburg.**

**Made public the quarterly earnings report** for the second quarter of 2013 for non-telephone fixed

utilities with jurisdictional operating revenues of more than \$10 million.

**Adopted the proposed opinions and orders** vacating the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision and remanding the proceeding to the Office of Administrative Law Judge in the case of J3 Energy Group Inc. vs. **West Penn Power Co. and UGI Development Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Airport Executive Car Service (**Allegheny County**); approving the settlement agreement between I&E and **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**, which includes a \$60,000 civil penalty regarding improper transfer of a restoration crew in the wake of the Oct. 29, 2011, snowstorm; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Caroline Chang vs. **Pennsylvania American Water Co.**; granting the motion for default judgment in the case of I&E vs. Yes Express (**Washington County**) and directing the company to pay \$128, which includes an outstanding assessment balance of \$25 and a civil penalty of \$103 for the alleged violations; and granting the joint petition for approval of an interconnection agreement between **CenturyLink** and MegaPack Corp.

**Approved the 911 system renewal plans** for the City of Allentown (**Lehigh County**) and **McKean, Lancaster and Clearfield counties.**

**Adopted the motion of Chairman Powelson** on the proposed storm damage expense rider of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**

**Adopted the motion of Vice Chairman Coleman** in the case of Kisha Dorsey vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works.**
