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Approved applications for Legends PA Inc. (**Monroe, Pike and Luzerne counties**); Suburban Emergency Medical Services (**Lehigh, Northampton and Monroe counties**); Healthfleet Ambulance Inc. (**Columbia, Montour, Northumberland, Luzerne and Lycoming counties**); Greens Taxi Inc. (**Washington County**); Pennsylvania American Water Co. – Wastewater (**Adams County**); Regional Community Transit (**Schuylkill County**); Raymond Shirk (**Lancaster County**); Amerex Brokers Inc.; PPL Electric Utilities Corp. for approval of the siting and reconstruction of the Double Circuit 138/69-kV Lake Harmony-Lake Naomi transmission line in portions of **Monroe and Carbon counties**; Pennsylvania American Water Co. (**Butler County**); Santanna Natural Gas Corp.; American Life Ambulance (**Bucks County**); Little Washington Wastewater Co. (**Chester County**); Plymouth Rock Energy LLC; Aqua Pennsylvania Inc. (**Chester County**); Scioto Energy; Onvoy Voice Services; and Birch Communications Inc.

Dismissed the application of Visit Vans LLC (**Lehigh County**).

Approved the license amendment for Compass Energy Services Inc.

Approved applications for discontinuance or abandonment of service for Exelon Energy Company – Electric; World Connect; and ABS-CBN Telecom North America Inc.

Made public Superior Water Company's Audit Report and Implementation Plan.

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders denying the respondent's exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Bureau of Transportation and Safety vs. **All-Star Limousines**; denying the exceptions of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT), the railroad, and the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E), and adopting the recommended decision in the case

of A. Edward Schwartz vs. **Canadian Pacific Railroad** and PennDOT; granting the petitions, rescinding the December 2012 order, and the June 2012 and May 2013 secretarial letters in the cases of I&E vs. **JRSB Hauling**; approving the settlement agreement with **MXEnergy/ Constellation Energy Power Choice** following an informal investigation pertaining to alleged erroneous customer enrollment and the company's door-to-door sales practices; granting, in part, and denying, in part, the exceptions, modifying the initial decision, dismissing the complaint and referring certain operational and safety matters to I&E in the case of Jeremy Kashuba vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the ALJ's initial decision in the case of William J. Femea Sr. vs. **UGI Penn Natural Gas Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge (ALJ) initial decisions, as modified, related to the objections to annual assessments for fiscal years 2010-11 and 2011-12 filed by **Unique Limousine Service Inc.**; and denying the petition by Comfort Limousine Service Inc. (**Bucks and Philadelphia counties**) to request a waiver from the eight-model-year requirement.

Adopted the proposed orders approving the application and granting the petition of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** with respect to the Fountain Hill Nos. 1 and 2 138/69-kV Tap Line in Salisbury Township, **Lehigh County**; approving the asset purchase agreement for **Columbia Gas of PA Inc.**; and approving the affiliated interest agreement and registering the securities certificate for **Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC** concerning the issuance of promissory notes between the company and **PNG Companies LLC**.

Adopted the proposed tentative order to reduce the amount of the bonding requirement for **electric generation suppliers (EGSs)** after their initial year of operation and expanding the type of security instruments that can be used to satisfy the bonding requirement.

Approved the 911 system renewal plan for Wayne County.

Adopted the initial decision of the ALJ sustaining in part and denying in part the complaint and ordering a payment arrangement in the case of Thanh Nguyen vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**.

Adopted the ALJ's recommended decision accepting the statement in the case of Pittston Township (Luzerne County) vs. **Reading Blue Mountain & Northern Railroad**; approving the settlement without modification for **NRG Energy Center Harrisburg LLC (Dauphin County)**; and approving the settlement for **City of Dubois – Bureau of Water (Clearfield County)**.

Adopted the orders approving the petitions of **Peoples Twp. LLC** and **Budget Phone**.

Issued for comment the proposed settlement agreement resolving the issues related to an information investigation by I&E regarding Handy Delivery Inc.'s (**Centre County**) alleged underreporting of revenue in its assessment report for the 2011 calendar year.

Entered into the minutes the notational voting to adopt an order granting reconsideration pending review of the merits in the case of **J3 Energy Group Inc. vs. West Penn Power Co.** and **UGI Development Co.**

Approved the appointment of Jean C. Black to the Board of Directors of the **Sustainable Energy Fund of Central Eastern Pennsylvania** and Brian J. Hill as an advisory board member of the **Met-Ed/Penelec Sustainable Energy Fund**.

Adopted the joint motion of Vice Chairman Coleman and **Commissioner Brown** in the case of Ken Eernisse vs. Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.

Adopted the motion of Commissioner Witmer in the case of Fred Lavner vs. **PECO Energy Company**.

Adopted the motions of Commissioner Brown related to the natural gas supplier application of **Tiger Natural Gas Inc.** and in the case of Michael John Sottile vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**.
