PUC - INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT VS PUBLIC **POWER LLC**

- In Sept. 2014, the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) instituted an informal investigation regarding allegations that Public Power, as a result of its billing and/or marketing actions, may have violated provisions of Chapters 54 and 57 of the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa Code, among other statutes and regulations, concerning the standards regarding the marketing and sales practices of an electric generation supplier. Based on its investigation, I&E determined that for the monthly invoices of January through April of 2014, there were a total of 119 instances, impacting 50 customers in which Public Power failed to adhere to the terms of its "15% Price Protection Plan," thereby billing these customers charges in excess of the Plan's guaranteed pricing. I&E was prepared to allege the above in a formal complaint. On 10/21/15, the parties submitted a proposed Settlement Agreement and Statements in Support of the Settlement Agreement to resolve this matter.

That the Commission adopt the proposed Opinion and Order that issues the Settlement Agreement for comments.
