Dear Secretary McNulty:

On March 4, 2010, the Philadelphia Area Industrial Energy Users Group ("PAIEUG") filed a Petition for Reconsideration and Amendment ("Petition") with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") in response to the PUC's February 17, 2010 Order approving PECO's Energy Efficiency & Conservation ("EE&C") Plan. Specifically, PAIEUG raised concerns with the Company's intent to implement a cap on the amount of incentives that individual customers might obtain through the EE&C Plan.

Since filing the aforementioned Petition, PAIEUG has spoken with PECO, who indicated to PAIEUG that, at this time, the Companies will not impose any limit on available program incentives for individual customers under the Company's EE&C program. To that end, PECO has removed all references to a monetary cap from Company materials. In addition, PECO has agreed that it will not seek to impose a monetary cap on its EE&C Plan programs without first obtaining Commission approval. While PAIEUG does not necessarily agree with placing caps on customer participation in the EE&C programs, PAIEUG agrees that any such proposed modification would require a formal filing with the Commission and requisite approval.

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Based upon the aforementioned representations by PECO, PAIEUG believes that the concerns raised in Petition have been resolved, and for this reason, PAIEUG withdraws its Petition at this time.
