MOTION OF PHILADELPHIA HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANT'S BRIEF

Philadelphia Housing Authority ("PHA"), submits this motion requesting an extension of time to file its direct testimony on the above-captioned matter until April 1, 2010. In specific support of this motion, PHA states as follows:

1. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "PUC") set a procedural schedule in this matter on March 2, 2010 (the "Order"). Pursuant to the Order, direct testimony of all parties is due on March 26, 2010.

2. Counsel for PHA seeks an extension of time to file its direct testimony because PHA only recently received responses to some of its interrogatories (on March 19, 2010), and because PHA is currently in discussions with PGW regarding a dispute as to four of its interrogatories.

3. As a result, PHA does not have all of the relevant information it requires for its direct testimony, and has filed a motion to compel responses to its discovery requests with the PUC.

4. Accordingly, PHA requests a one week extension (until April 1, 2010) to allow adequate time to review the recently-served discovery responses and to resolve the current discovery dispute before preparing and submitting its direct testimony.

5. Counsel for all parties have been contacted with regard to the present motion, and no objections to PHA's request for an extension of time have been received.

6. PHA does not intend to offer direct testimony as to the appropriateness of rate increases or decreases.

WHEREFORE, Philadelphia Housing Authority respectfully requests the Commission grant it an extension of seven (7) days from the Commission's Order to file its direct testimony, until April 1, 2010, so as to allow adequate time to review the recently-served discovery responses, resolve the current discovery dispute, and prepare direct testimony.


