Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

PECO Energy Company ("PECO") provides this update on the Implementation of its Smart Meter Technology Procurement and Installation Plan which was approved by the Commission with certain modifications on May 6, 2010 (the "Plan") in the above-captioned docket. Specifically, PECO is providing information about the progress of its initial dynamic pricing and customer acceptance program as described in the Plan.

In the Plan, PECO noted its intention to seek Commission approval of programs to implement initial dynamic pricing options, educate customers and assess customer acceptance of dynamic pricing programs through a June 2010 filing. However, in light of discussions with stakeholders and other considerations, PECO now proposes to make this filing in September 2010. A September filing date will still allow for acceptable IT build time and will be helpful for the following reasons:

- It will allow PECO to accommodate stakeholder concerns about overlap with rate case filings, as the September filing will come during a less active time in the PECO rate case;
- It will provide additional time for stakeholders to absorb the proposed pricing and plan concepts; and
- It will permit PECO to complete its sub-hourly metering cost benefit analysis requested by the Commission in its order approving the Plan.

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

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
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
