
As requested, the Companies have enclosed a copy of the General Terms and Conditions that apply to the agreement between FirstEnergy Service Company (on behalf of the Companies) and Honeywell International Inc. ("Honeywell") to provide program management services for the approved Residential Direct Load Program which was initially submitted for Commission approval on February 24, 2011.

As indicated in the submission of February 24, 2011, the General Terms and Conditions that apply to this agreement are the same General Terms and Conditions for Purchase of Conservation Service Provider Services, which was approved by the Commission by Secretarial Letter dated April 27, 2009, and modified and used by the Companies for the Honeywell Utility Solutions contract for the provision of Conservation Service Provider Services to manage the Companies' Residential Energy Efficiency and Conservation Programs. These modified General Terms and Conditions for Purchase of Conservation Provider services were submitted to the Commission staff on December 22, 2009 with the initial Honeywell Utility Solutions contract, and was subsequently approved by Secretarial Letter dated January 7, 2010.


