Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, LLC (CNEG) is a licensed Natural Gas Supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.¹ CNEG is currently authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to provide natural gas services to the public within the service territories of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc., National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, UGI Utilities, Inc., Equitable Gas Company, T. W. Phillips Gas and Oil Company, Peoples Natural Gas Company, Philadelphia Gas Works, and PECO Energy Company. CNEG is authorized to provide natural gas services to small and large commercial, governmental, and industrial customers located within the service territories of these utilities.

CNEG herein respectfully requests the Commission amend CNEG's existing license to also include the UGI Central Penn, UGI Penn Natural, and Valley Energy service territories. If approved, in addition to its present business activities, CNEG intends to solicit natural gas-related business from small and large commercial, governmental, and industrial customers located within these three service territories.

Based upon information from Commission Staff, CNEG understands the following information is required to support its request:

1. Evidence that CNEG has met the creditworthiness standards of UGI Central Penn, UGI Penn Natural, and Valley Energy.

¹ The initial license was granted in the name Alliance Energy Services Partnership (Alliance Energy) on April 5, 2001. On April 28, 2004 the Commission approved the request by Alliance Energy to change the name on its license to Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, LLC.

Enclosed are copies of CNEG's initial newspaper notices in the Philadelphia Inquirer, Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, Patriot News, Erie Times-News, Scranton Times, and Williamsport Sun-Gazette stating CNEG's intent to sell natural gas and related services throughout all of Pennsylvania. CNEG understands that if the initial newspaper notices indicated intent to provide service statewide, then notice at this time to support the request herein is not required.

RE: UGI Financial Security Requirements

Dear Mr. Baker,

UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGI") has reviewed the financial information of Constellation Energy Group, Inc ("Constellation"). Based on this review and the requirement that Constellation must post security as specified in the UGI Penn Natural Gas ("PNG") and UGI Central Penn Gas ("CPG") Supplier Coordination Tariffs before it serves customers on the PNG and CPG distribution systems, UGI has determined that Constellation has demonstrated adequate creditworthiness to satisfy any costs PNG and CPG may incur in the event they operate as a supplier of last resort due to a default on the part of Constellation.

This determination may change in the event there is a material deterioration in that condition, if Constellation's obligations to PNG and CPG exceed the amount of the financial security provided, if the financial security is withdrawn or is deemed to be null and void or inadequate due to the material financial deterioration of any guarantor, or if Constellation fails to abide by the terms and conditions of PNG and CPG Gas Tariffs and the PNG and CPG Natural Gas Supplier Coordination Tariffs.


