AT&T'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER

AT&T Communications of Pennsylvania, LLC and TCG Pittsburgh (“AT&T” and “TCG,” collectively “AT&T”) hereby file this Motion for an extension of time to file an Answer to Core Communications Inc.’s (“Core”) Petition to Reopen the Record. This Motion is unopposed. In support of this Motion, AT&T states as follows:

1. On April 13, 2011, Core filed a Petition to Reopen the Record to introduce two new exhibits.
2. AT&T was served via first class mail.
3. AT&T’s Answer to Core’s Petition is due April 28, 2011, due to the three day mailbox rule.
4. One of AT&T’s primary attorneys in this matter, Theodore Livingston, has been out of the country since the Petition was filed.
5. On April 20, 2011, Michelle Painter contacted counsel for Core, Deanne O’Dell, and requested an extension of time to file AT&T’s Answer. Ms. O’Dell agreed to give AT&T until May 3, 2011 to file its Answer.

6. Pursuant to a request by Administrative Law Judge Angela Jones, AT&T is filing this Motion to formally request that the Commission grant AT&T an extension of time until May 3, 2011 to file its Answer.

7. AT&T's request is unopposed and therefore AT&T submits that there is no basis to deny the Motion for an extension of less than one week to file its Answer.

WHEREFORE AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission grant this unopposed Motion and permit AT&T an extension of time to file its Answer such that AT&T's Answer to Core's Petition to Reopen the Record is due on May 3, 2011.
