
On April 15, 2011, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered an Order in the above referenced matter that, among other things: (1) approved PECO Energy Company's Initial Dynamic Pricing and Customer Acceptance Plan, as modified by the Joint Petition for Partial Settlement (the "Joint Petition"); and (2) authorized PECO to file a tariff supplement in substantially the same form as Exhibit 1 to the Joint Petition.

In reviewing the Order, PECO identified an error that it would like to bring to the Commission's attention. On page 6, the Order describes PECO's time-of use ("TOU") rate and states that the "peak period is defined as between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on non-holiday *summer* weekdays (*June through September*)." (emphasis added). In fact, the peak period for PECO's TOU rate is *not* limited to the summer months, but rather, as described in the approved tariff supplement (Joint Petition Exhibit 1), comprises "the hours between 2 pm and 6 pm . . . daily except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays." See Joint Petition Ex. 1, Original Page No. 83A. Because the Order authorizes PECO to file a tariff supplement in substantially the form set forth in Joint Petition Exhibit 1, the Company does not believe that a formal correction or modification of the Order is necessary.



