AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF NORTHAMPTON, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING UNCONVENTIONAL GAS WELL FEE ON EACH UNCONVENTIONAL GAS WELL SPUD IN NORTHAMPTON

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED By the Northampton County Council as follows:

Section 1. The County of Northampton hereby imposes and unconventional gas well fee on each unconventional gas well spud in this County, as authorized in Title 58.

Section 2. Definitions. The following words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings given to them this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Fee." The unconventional gas well fee imposed under Section 2302 of Title 58.

"Spud." The actual start of drilling of an unconventional qas well.

"Title 58." Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes as amended by Act of February 14, 2012 (P.L.87, No.13):

"Unconventional gas well." A bore hole drilled or being drilled for the purpose of or to be used for the production of natural gas from an unconventional formation.

Section 3. The unconventional gas well fee shall applicable, and shall be administered, as provided for in Title 58.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after date of enactment, and shall remain in effect until repealed or amended.

Section 5. A copy of this ordinance shall be transmitted to the Public Utility Commission as required by Title 58.

This ordinance was advertised on the $7^{\rm th}$ day of April 2012, and was adopted by the Northampton County Council on the $19^{\rm th}$ day of April 2012.
