

PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES, the Commission on Economic Opportunity (CEO), by and through counsel, Joseph L. Vullo, Esquire, and petitions to intervene in the above-captioned matter averring as follows:

1. The Petitioner, Commission on Economic Opportunity, is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal office located at 165 Amber Lane, P.O. Box 1127, Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, 18703-1127. CEO's telephone number is (570) 826-0510.

2. CEO is an advocate for its clients - the low income population of Luzerne County - and has been directly involved in assuring that low income persons' utility costs are contained through counseling, advice, payment assistance and energy conservation measures.

3. CEO seeks permission to intervene in PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's Supplement No. 118 to Tariff - Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 filed with the Commission.

4. CEO is a customer of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation and CEO serves clients who are customers of PPL.

5. CEO seeks permission to intervene in PPL's request for a rate increase not only to address the proposed increase but to ensure the adequacy of the Company's programs for its low

income customers and the effect of any proposed rate increase or change in rate structure on those programs and customers.

6. CEO's participation as an active party in this proceeding is required to protect its substantial interests and the substantial interests of the low income citizens it represents in ensuring that utility rates remain affordable for its clients and to ensure that its low income programs remain adequately funded and available. Accordingly, CEO's participation in this proceeding will serve the public interest.

7. Because CEO represents low income citizens in Luzerne County, the interests of its clients are not being protected by any other party to this action.

POSITIONS

8. CEO reserves the right to set forth its position on the proposed rate increase. CEO's main purpose is to address the adequacy of the Company's low income programs and the effect of any proposed rate increase or change in rate structure on those programs and the Company's low income customers.

9. There is a substantial public interest in keeping utility costs affordable for all members of the community and any increase in rates should be accompanied by an increase in funding available to the Company's low income programs so that its rates remain just and reasonable across all customer classes.

10. CEO expects to address the proposed increase in the monthly customer charge along with the proposed rate structure as those changes impact upon the motive and ability of low income customers to reduce their monthly bills through conservation.

11. CEO has been an active participant in this Company's prior requests for rate increases.


REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Commission on Economic Opportunity respectfully requests that the Commission:

1. Receive for filing and docket this Petition to Intervene in order that CEO be a party to such proceedings and be placed on all service lists.
2. Grant to CEO active party status with the right to participate in all proceedings relative to this matter.



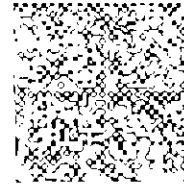
