Enclosed for filing, please find an original and three copies of Duquesne Light Company's ("Duquesne Light" or "Company") proposed Conservation Service Provider ("CSP") Agreement for its Demand Side Response Initiative. The CSP Agreement includes exhibits A-D. Duquesne Light respectfully request that the CSP Agreement and exhibits be treated as Confidential and not be included in the public record. Additionally, the Company respectfully request accelerated approval within 30 days in order to implement this program as soon as possible and achieve its Act 129 targets.

Act 129 requires the Commission to establish procedures to review all proposed energy efficiency contracts with CSPs prior to execution of the contract. 66 Pa.C.S.§2806.1(a)(8). The Company considering all of the relevant factors deemed important by the Commission in its Implementation Order at Docket No, M-2008-2069887, including knowledge, background and experience of personnel to be utilized, quality of the work plan or approach, timeliness of performance, and other relevant factors. The selected CSP is a PUC approved and registered CSP under Docket No, A-2009-2096837.
