- (a) Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc.  
Rate increase filed on behalf of 15 participating member carriers.  
M. F. Rockey Moving Co., Camp Hill, Cumberland County, et al.

(b) Petition for proposed increase in household goods and related articles transported 40 miles or less on behalf of its participating carriers in Adams, Cumberland and Dauphin Counties (3.74%); Indiana County (3.47%); Erie County (2.33%) and Chester County (8.1%); all to recover increases in labor and other operating costs. If approved, rate increases for the 15 member carriers will produce a total of \$126,665 in increased revenues.

(c) The Bureau recommends that the proposed increases be approved to become effective October 7, 1989 as scheduled in 4th Revised Page 45, 4th Revised Page 48, 3rd Revised Page 49 and 4th Revised Page 74 to Tariff Freight PA PUC No. 50.
