

STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER CAWLEY

We have before us the informal investigations of ResCom Energy LLC (ResCom) instituted in September 2012 and July 2013, pertaining to allegations of slamming (an unauthorized change to a customer's supply service) and related unauthorized electric generation supplier marketing practices within Pennsylvania. On December 2, 2013, the parties submitted a Settlement Agreement and Statements in Support of the Settlement Agreement to resolve this matter. On March 19, 2014, the Commission issued an Order directing the parties to file Supplemental Statements in Support of the Settlement. The parties filed Supplemental Statements on April 11, 2014.

The slamming allegations stemmed from three customers who were physically switched and were customers of ResCom for a period before being returned to their prior EGS. While the record clearly describes the activities alleged and how many customers were affected, it provides no information on the treatment of these three affected customers. Were these customers financially harmed by the alleged slam? If so, were these customers compensated? Since this tentative order is being issued for comment, I ask the parties to elaborate on the treatment of these three customers.
