

Please be advised that 66 Pa. C.S. § 3018(b)(2) gives interexchange carriers (IXCs) three options regarding intrastate tariffs: (1) operate as a detariffed IXC<sup>1</sup> by submitting a letter to the Secretary's Bureau canceling their respective tariff on file with the Commission and withdrawing any pending tariff supplements, (2) maintain a price list in lieu of a tariff by submitting a letter to the Secretary's Bureau (updates to price lists will be processed in the same manner as tariff revisions), or (3) continue to maintain a tariff with the Commission following the current process.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Questions in this matter may be directed to David Ehrhart, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services at (717) 783-6174.
