3 Protestant's counsel has a conflicting matter scheduled for 8 am, August 19, 2014 before the Court of Common Pleas of Lebanon County, Pennsylvania.

4 Further, the Due Process rights, such as granted by the Commission, of the

statewide Protestants requires further preparation time for a Hearing which, based on all the filings in this and related cases, could determine the future existence and economic viability of said Protestants.

5 Respondent Capital City Cab Service will not request a second continuance in this case.

6 Respondent requested concurrence of all the listed counsel, received three responses. Justine Pate, Esq., representing Keystone Cab Service, etc., and David Donley, Esq., representing JB Taxi, concurred. Karen Moury, Esq., representing Applicant, did not concur.
