**INTERROGATORIES AND REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS
ADDRESSED TO THE APPLICANT**

The Insurance Federation of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Insurance Federation"), pursuant to 52 Pa.Code Section 5.321 et seq., submits the following Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents to Rasier PA, LLC ("the Applicant") and demands the Applicant file and serve full and complete written answers to each Interrogatory and Request under oath within five (5) days after the date of service hereof. These interrogatories and requests shall be of a continuing nature with the understanding that it shall be the responsibility of the Applicant to furnish updated responses up to and including the time at which the hearing on the merits of this case is held.

Interrogatories

1. Please admit or deny that the Applicant proposes to satisfy 52 Pa.Code Sections 32.11(a) and (b) and 41.21 and 52 Pa.Code Section 3.381(e), regarding insurance coverage and proof of insurance coverage, as set

forth by the Applicant in Sections II and IV of its Application filed with the Commission on April 14, 2014.

2. If the preceding Interrogatory is not admitted without qualification, please set forth any changes the Applicant proposes to satisfy 52 Pa.Code Sections 32.11(a) and (b) and 41.21 and 52 Pa.Code Section 3.381(e), regarding insurance coverage and proof of insurance coverage.

3. If changes are set forth in the answer to the preceding Interrogatory, please identify any documents or other sources setting forth such changes, including any revisions to the Applications and any materials related to the insurance coverage the Applicant proposes, including but not limited to any proposed Form E and any insurance policies identified in that form.

4. Please admit or deny that the Applicant proposes to direct all of its operators and drivers to notify their personal auto insurers, in writing, of their intent to operate in Applicant's service.

5. If the preceding Interrogatory is admitted, please admit or deny that the Applicant proposes to maintain copies of its operators' and drivers' notifications to their personal auto insurers during their affiliation with the Applicant and for a period of three (3) years following termination of their affiliation and service.

6. Please admit or deny that the Applicant proposes to notify its operators and drivers, in writing, whether it is providing comprehensive and collision coverage during their service and affiliation with the Applicant.

7. If the preceding Interrogatory is admitted, please admit or deny that the Applicant proposes to maintain a copy of each notification for a period of three (3) years following termination of its operators' and drivers' affiliation and service.

8. If Interrogatories 4 through 8 are admitted, please identify any documents or other sources setting forth the manner in which the Applicant proposes to perform the actions set forth therein, including any revisions to the Applications.

Request for Production of Documents

1. Please produce all documents or other sources identified in your Answer to Interrogatory 3.
2. Please produce all documents or other sources related to terms and conditions between the Applicant and its operators and drivers pertaining to the insurance the Applicant requires of its operators and drivers and the insurance it proposes to provide to its operators and drivers.
3. Please produce all documents or other sources identified in your Answer to Interrogatory 8.
