As Your Honor knows, there is currently a telephonic Prehearing Conference scheduled in the above-referenced matter for Monday, September 8, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. As Your Honor is also aware, there is a pending petition for interlocutory review of the Interim Order issued in this case on July 22, 2014. In a Secretarial Letter dated August 13, 2014, the Commission advised that the petition will be addressed at a forthcoming Public Meeting. By this correspondence, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. ("FES") respectfully requests, pursuant to 52 Pa.
