UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division’s tariff currently includes two different transportation services. One service, Delivery Service, is designed for the larger commercial and industrial customers. The second serves small commercial and residential customers (Customer Choice customers).

Your license application with the Pennsylvania Utility Commission that UGI has on file, indicates that Alliance Energy Services wants to serve UGI’s industrial customers that would be covered by UGI’s Delivery Service rate schedule. We are pleased that Alliance Energy Services Partnership ("Alliance") is intending to provide Natural Gas Supply Service on the distribution system of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia Gas").
