Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On October 14, 2014, Mr. Michael S. Henry filed Exceptions in the above-captioned matter on behalf of Concord Limousine, Inc. ("Concord Limousine") and Executive Transportation Company, Inc. ("Executive Transportation") to the Recommended Decision, which was served on September 25, 2014. For reasons explained below, Rasier-PA LLC is not filing Reply Exceptions to those Exceptions.

Per the Secretarial Letter dated September 25, 2014, Exceptions were due on October 10, 2014. As the Exceptions of Concord Limousine and Executive Transportation were untimely filed, they should be disregarded by the Commission.


