

STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER GLADYS M. BROWN

Lyft, Inc. (Lyft) seeks Commission approval to provide experimental service of Transportation Network Company for passenger trips between points in Allegheny county, as well as state-wide.

I believe that this type of service can be beneficial to the public, especially in underserved neighborhoods throughout the Commonwealth. This Commission is certainly not against new and innovative services, but we have a responsibility to uphold the laws as they are currently written. That being said, the success or failure of Transportation Network Companies, such as Lyft, depends solely on their propensity to operate safely and within the confines of our laws. Lyft's conduct over the next few months will establish its future operations in Pennsylvania. If it chooses not to comply with the regulatory requirements established in this order, I will not hesitate to seek further enforcement action.
