On December 30, 2014, Respond Power LLC ("Respond Power") filed a Motion for Scheduling of Settlement Conference and Assignment of Settlement Judge ("Motion") in the above-captioned matter. Due to the hearings scheduled for March 9-13, 2015, Respond Power asked for this to occur by mid-January 2015 to optimize the likelihood of successful settlement negotiations avoiding the need for those hearings. By Order dated January 2, 2015, Your Honors directed that all objections or responses to Respond Power's Motion be filed on or before January 9, 2015.

Respond Power and the parties held a settlement conference call on January 7, 2015. Due to the productive discussions engaged in by the parties during that call, Respond Power respectfully asks that Your Honors hold the Motion in abeyance.
