Dear Ms. Armstrong:

By Order entered October 25, 2001, at Docket Nos. A-311014, A-311014F0002, and A-311014F0003, the Commission approved the application of Armstrong Telecommunications. Inc. to provide services as a Non Facilities-Based and Facilities-Based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC), Interexchange Carrier Reseller (IXC) and Competitive Access Provider (CAP) to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff Telephone Nos. 1, 3 and 4, with an effective date of December 13, 2001.

This letter is to notify you that the CLEC Tariff No. 1, CAP Tariff No. 3, and IXC Tariff No. 4 has been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariff is just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit the tariff to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariff.
