**In compliance with Ordering Paragraph 8 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility  
Commission Order entered March 4, 2015 in the above captioned matter, Verizon  
will publish a notice in newspapers serving the affected areas informing  
customers that the services at issue will be reclassified as competitive and will be  
detariffed pursuant to the Commission's Order.**

**The newspapers (Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, Erie Mirror Times, Harrisburg Patriot  
News, York Dispatch, Allentown Morning Call, Scranton Times Tribune, Wilkes-  
Barre Times Leader, Philadelphia Daily News, and the Philadelphia Inquirer) are  
the same as those approved by the Commission and used by the Company in its  
original notice in October, 2014. The newspaper placements will be made on or  
before April 1, 2015.**

Verizon will also provide written notification of the change in regulatory status to each affected customer in the areas covered by the Order at least 30 days prior to the actual detariffing, including a reference to Verizon's web-based Product Guide.
