Dear Mr. Ferguson:

By Order entered October 25, 2000, at Docket Nos. A-310932, A-310932F0002, A-310932F0003, and A-310932F0004, the Commission approved the applications of Broadview Networks, Inc. for approval to offer, render, furnish, or supply telecommunication services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 1 to offer Competitive Local Exchange Carrier services, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 2 to offer Reseller of Interexchange services, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 3 to offer Interexchange Carrier services, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 4 to offer Competitive Access Services, and Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 5 to offer Switched Access services, all to become effective December 22, 2000.

This letter is to notify you that Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 1, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 2, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 3, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 4, and Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 5 will be permitted to become effective on December 22, 2000. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariff is just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit this tariff to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariff.
