

Dear Secretary McNulty:

On April 10, 2000, Broadview Networks, Inc. ("Broadview") received a Secretarial letter from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") granting Broadview provisional authority to provide services as a Reseller of Toll Services, Interexchange Carrier, and Reseller of Local Exchange Carrier Services. Broadview did not receive provisional authority to provide facilities-based services at that time because Broadview had not yet filed a facilities-based tariff. On July 18, 2000, Broadview filed a facilities-based tariff with the Commission. The fifteen day protest period will close on August 2, 2000.

In order to receive the company codes necessary for provisioning of facilities-based service, Broadview must provide NANPA with proof that it has received facilities-based authority from the Commission. It is our understanding that NANPA only provides codes within the first five business days of each month, Broadview must provide NANPA with proof of facilities-based authority no later than Monday, August 7, 2000. For this reason, Broadview respectfully requests that the Commission provide Broadview with a Secretarial letter reflecting the grant of provisional authority to provide facilities-based service, on August 3, 2000.
