APPLICATION FOR A SUBPOENA**


On March 17, 2015, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement filed an Application for a Subpoena of Johnathan J. Feldman to appear and testify at the evidentiary hearing in this complaint proceeding, pursuant to 52 Pa.Code § 5.421. Mr. Feldman has been identified by Uber Technologies, Inc. as the General Manager of Uber Pennsylvania. Uber does not object to the subpoena.

We note that at the time the application for a subpoena was filed, an evidentiary hearing had not yet been scheduled in these proceedings. A hearing has now been scheduled on May 6, 2015, therefore we have altered the proposed subpoena to include the date and time of the hearing.
