By Opinion and Order entered June 19, 1998 at Docket Nos. A-310470, A-310470 F0002 and A-310646 F0003, the Commission approved the amended applications of Hyperion Telecommunications of PA, Inc., to provide interexchange toll services, to operate as a competitive local exchange carrier within the service territories of Bell Atlantic-Pennsylvania, Inc., and GTE North, Inc., and to operate as a competitive access provider in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Approved at this public meeting were the following applications and tariffs:

Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. Nos. 1, 2 and 3 were filed with an effective date of August 20, 1998. Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 4 was filed with an effective date of October 19, 1998.

This letter is to notify you that these tariffs have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit these tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariff.
