Dear Mr. Schwencke:

During a routine review of the telecommunications tariffs, the Full Service Network LP, CLEC Tariff No 1 and IXC-FB Tariff No 2, revealed sections that are not in compliance with Commission Policies, Regulations and/or Orders. However, the recommended changes do not constitute a determination that all tariff pages of each reviewed tariff, are just, lawful, and reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time.

Full Service Network LP, CLEC Telephone Tariff Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, Original page 17 needs to be updated to the current surcharge rates set at Docket No. M-2011-2218783, Order entered May 20, 2011. The current Order can be found on the PUC web page at <u>http://www.puc.state.pa.us/general/onlineforms/pdf/TRS_Surcharge_Remittance11-12.pdf</u>. The rates set with this Order for residence and business is \$0.08 per access line per month for bills issued on or after July 1, 2011.

Full Service Network LP, IXC-FB Telephone Tariff Pa. P.U.C. No. 2,1st Revised Page 16, shows a <u>Regulatory Cost Recovery Surcharge of \$2.77/month/line</u>. This charge must be removed from the tariff. Please note that it is the Commission's policy that this type of charge may be included in the rate for service instead of being imposed as a separate line item charge.

Please file a tariff supplement to correct the above pages for each tariff discussed and use the next supplement number relating to each tariff. Provide an original and three copies addressed to Rosemary Chiavetta, Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.

Please be advised that 66 Pa. C.S. § 3018(b)(2) gives interexchange carriers (IXCs) three options regarding intrastate tariffs: (1) operate as a detariffed IXC¹ by submitting a letter to the

¹ Detariffed IXCs remain subject to state contract laws.

Secretary's Bureau canceling their respective tariff on file with the Commission and withdrawing any pending tariff supplements, (2) maintain a price list in lieu of a tariff by submitting a letter to the Secretary's Bureau (updates to price lists will be processed in the same manner as tariff revisions), or (3) continue to maintain a tariff with the Commission following the current process.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
