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

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Pursuant to Section 2807(e) of the Public Utility Code, on November 3, 2015, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company filed a Joint Petition for Approval of their Default Service Implementation Plans (“Plans”) for the period June 1, 2017 to May 31, 2019.

II. REVIEW OF THE PLANS

2. At this time, NextEra is reviewing the Plans and still formulating its position on the issues, including any position on settlement. NextEra is also considering the extent to which it will participate in the proceedings, and, thus, does not have a specific position on scheduling and discovery. NextEra reserves the right to present in this proceeding direct, rebuttal, and surrebuttal fact and expert testimony, to the extent it deems necessary. If it does submit testimony, it is anticipated NextEra will offer one witness, and NextEra will notify the Administrative Law Judge and all parties of the witness’s identity as appropriate.
