

PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE
PURSUANT TO 71 P.S. SECTION 309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. Section 309-2, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Consumer Advocate determined to intervene and participate in the Joint Petition for Consolidation of Proceedings and Approval of Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plans (EE&C Plan) Phase III of Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company and West Penn Power Company (Joint Petition).

On November 23, 2015, Pennsylvania Power Company (Penn Power or Company) filed the Joint Petition, pursuant to Section 2806.1 of the Public Utility Code and pursuant to the Implementation Order entered by the Commission at Docket No. M-2014-2424864 on June 19, 2015. The five-year cost of the Company's EE&C Phase III Plan is projected to be \$33,298,945. Penn Power EE&C Plan at 17. The Company plans to reduce annual energy consumption by 161,622 MWh and to reduce demand by 17 MW by May 31, 2021. Penn Power EE&C Plan at App. E, Table 2. With respect to residential customers, Penn Power has proposed the following four residential customer energy efficiency programs: (1) Appliance Turn-In Program; (2) Home Performance Program; (3) Efficient Products Program; and (4) Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program. Id.

The Acting Consumer Advocate determined to intervene in this proceeding to protect the interests of Met-Ed's customers; to ensure that the proposed Plan and programs are in accordance with Act 129 and all other applicable statutes, regulations, and Commission Orders;

and to ensure that any increase in rates resulting from the adoption of the proposed programs and any related expenses are just and reasonable.


