

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C. S. § 2208 (c), an applicant for a natural gas supplier license in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania must furnish security to each utility where the supplier will do business to ensure the financial responsibility of such natural gas supplier. To this end, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“National Fuel”) will perform a credit review and analysis of Mansfield Power and Gas, LLC (“MPG”) and determine at the appropriate time whether MPG must post a security deposit acceptable to National Fuel in order to operate as a supplier on National Fuel’s system.

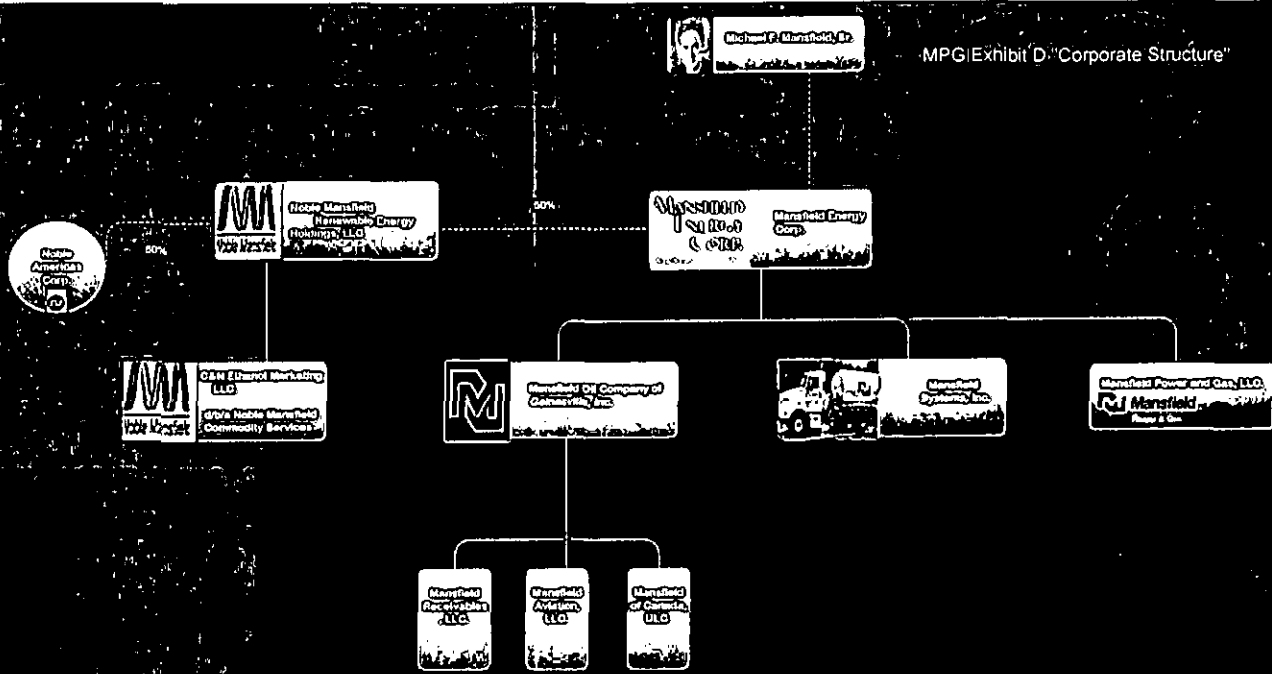

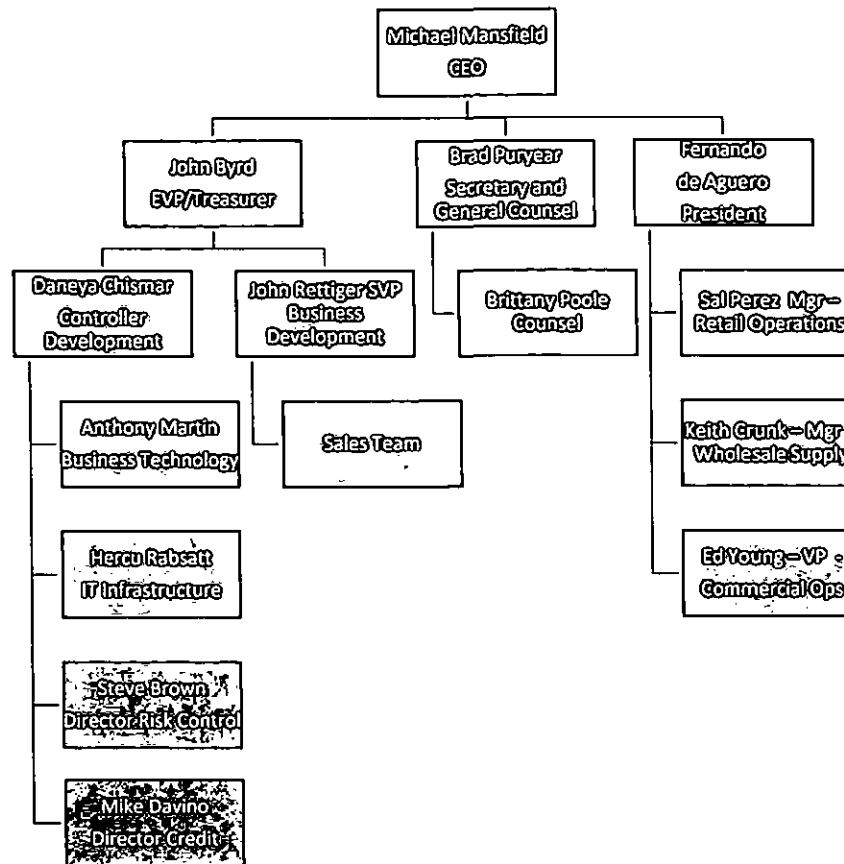
