**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF  
THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT  
AND ROSEMONT TAXICAB CO., INC.**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE DARLENE D. HEEP:

Pursuant to the Prehearing Order entered on November 30, 2015 in the above-captioned proceeding, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) and Rosemont Taxicab Co., Inc. (Rosemont) respectfully submit this joint status report with regard to the settlement of this matter.

**BACKGROUND**

1. By Hearing Notice dated September 18, 2015, an Initial In Person Hearing was scheduled for October 29, 2015 in this proceeding.
2. By e-mail dated October 27, 2015, I&E and Rosemont advised presiding Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Heep that the parties had reached a settlement-in-principle of this matter regarding payment of Respondent's assessments and civil penalty.
3. The hearing that was scheduled for October 29, 2015 was converted into an on-the-record telephonic conference during which details of the settlement-in-principle and procedure for moving forward were discussed.

4. Specifically, I&E and Rosemont agreed upon a payment schedule for a term of six (6) months wherein Rosemont will make monthly payments to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) that will satisfy all outstanding amounts due, the civil penalty of \$1,158 requested by I&E in this proceeding and a \$20 bounced check fee imposed by the Commission's Fiscal Office. The total amount included in the payment schedule is \$18,599.

5. Rosemont agreed to submit payments to the Commission pursuant to the following schedule:

- \$4,500 on or before November 23, 2015;
- \$4,500 on or before December 23, 2015;
- \$2,399 on or before January 23, 2016;
- \$2,400 on or before February 23, 2016;
- \$2,400 on or before March 23, 2016; and
- \$2,400 on or before April 23, 2016.

6. Upon receipt of the final payment on or before April 23, 2016, I&E would submit a Certificate of Satisfaction pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(a).

7. Regarding any breach of the above terms of the payment schedule, I&E would immediately request the scheduling of a hearing and make any necessary amendments to the Complaint.

8. By Prehearing Order entered November 30, 2015, this matter was held in abeyance until February 3, 2016, and the parties were directed to submit a joint status report by January 20, 2016.

9. In accordance with the above payment schedule, Rosemont submitted to the Commission \$4,500 in November 2015 and \$4,500 in December 2015. Both payments were applied towards Rosemont's outstanding assessments.


10. As indicated above, Rosemont is expected to pay various amounts over the next four months as set forth in the payment schedule to satisfy this matter. The next payment, totaling \$2,399, is due on or before January 23, 2016. The final payment is due on or before April 23, 2016.

11. Therefore, the parties respectfully request that this matter be held in abeyance until May 2, 2016, which would permit adequate time for the payment schedule to conclude and allow I&E to file a Certificate of Satisfaction at the above-docketed matter.
