PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE
OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE
PURSUANT TO 71 P.S. SECTION 309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. Section 309-2, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Consumer Advocate determined to file a Notice of Intervention and participate in proceedings before the Commission involving the Petition of UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (UGI).

On February 29, 2016, UGI Utilities, Inc.- Gas Division (UGI or the Company) filed a Petition for Approval of a Modification to its Long Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan. The OCA has determined to intervene and participate in these proceedings in order to protect the interests of UGI's customers. Through its participation, the OCA seeks to ensure that UGI's customers are afforded the protections to which they are entitled under the Public Utility Code and the Commission's regulations.
